 UNDER SECTION 4(1) OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION)
 ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1953, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN
 MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

1 The Ordinances set out in the second column of the Schedule to this Order are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent shown in the third column of the said Schedule.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the twenty-ninth day of May, 1953.
