ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, 1945, (No. 14 of 1945).

UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order shall be cited as the Buxton and Friendship Village District (Elections) Order, 1954.

2. For the purpose of the election of councillors, the Buxton and Friendship Village District on the east coast of the county of Demerara is hereby divided into two divisions, namely, the Buxton Division and the Friendship Division, the boundaries of which are described in the schedule hereto.

3. The number of councillors appointed to be elected by each division shall be as follows —

(a) by the Buxton Division, three councillors; and

(b) by the Friendship Division, three councillors.

SCHEDULE

1. (Boundaries of the Buxton Division).

On the north by the Atlantic Ocean, on the east by the Company Path between Buxton and Friendship, on the south by the northern boundary of Grant No. 1164 held by the East Demerara Water Commissioners, and on the west by Plantation La Reconnaisance.

2. (Boundaries of the Friendship Division).

On the north by the Atlantic Ocean, on the east by Platation Vigilance, on the south by the northern boundary of Grant No. 1164 held by the East Demerara Water Commissioners, and on the west by the Company Path between Buxton and Friendship.
