

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,

(No 69 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 8(b) OF THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Part III of the First Schedule to the Customs (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1952, as substituted by section 4(2) of the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1953, (which substituted the Second Schedule to the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1953, for Part III of the First Schedule to the Customs (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1952), is hereby amended by the addition thereto after item 54 of the following new item —

“55.(1) Supplies, equipment and materials introduced into the Colony by the Foreign Operations Administration of the Government of the United States of America, either directly or through contract with any public or private organisation, for purposes of effectuating the Agreement for technical co-operation reached between the Government of the Colony and the Government of the United States of America on the 12th day of July, 1954.

(2) Personal and household goods of all kinds for the personal use of themselves and members of their families, imported by personnel of the Government of the United States of America, whether employed directly by the said Government or under contract with a public or private organisation, in the Colony in connection with the technical co-operation programme to be carried out pursuant to the agreement referred to in (1) above.
