

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,
(No. 69 of 1952).

UNDER SECTION 42(2) OF THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. The following item shall be added to the list of restricted imports contained in the second schedule to the Customs (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1952:—

“ 9. Shirts, underwear and nightwear, unless each garment bears a cloth label securely sewn thereon stating the country of manufacture or unless such label is affixed at the time of importation.”

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st January, 1955.
