

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE PROVISIONAL COLLECTION OF TAXES ORDINANCE,
(CHAPTER 41).

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE PROVISIONAL COLLECTION OF TAXES ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE PROVISIONAL COLLECTION OF TAXES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1952, (No. 65 of 1952), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Provisional Collection of Taxes Order, 1954.

2. The introduction into the Legislative Council, during the present session which commenced on the 5th day of January, 1954, of the following Bills namely, —

- (a) A BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE, 1939;
- (b) A BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952,

is hereby approved.

3. The Comptroller of Customs and Excise is hereby ordered —

- (a) to demand, levy and collect on rum, other spirits and compounds the duties set forth in the aforesaid BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE TAX ORDINANCE, 1939, as the duties to be levied thereon instead of the duties payable thereon under the existing law;
- (b) to demand, levy and collect the duties set forth in the Schedule to the aforesaid BILL intituled AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE, 1952, as the duties to be levied on the articles set forth therein instead of the duties payable thereon under the existing law.
