

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1933,
(No. 11 of 1933).

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE SEA DEFENCE ORDINANCE, 1933, IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Sea Defence (Emergency Works) Order, 1954.
2. The Sea Defence Board is hereby required to take such immediate action and perform such works as may, in the opinion of the said Board, be necessary to avert or mitigate the inundation by the sea as a result of damage to the sea defence works between Plantations McNabb and Somerset and Berks, in the county of Essequibo.
3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 19th January, 1954.
