

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE UNDESIRABLE PUBLICATIONS (PROHIBITION OF
IMPORTATION) ORDINANCE, 1953,

(No. 4 of 1953).

WHEREAS the Governor in Council is of the opinion that the importation of the publications hereinafter set out would be contrary to the public interest:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power conferred by section 3 (1) of the Undesirable Publications (Prohibition of Importation) Ordinance, 1953, it is hereby ordered by the Governor in Council as follows:—

The importation of the following publications shall be prohibited:—

- (i) "British Guiana Workers fight against Poverty for Independence".
- (ii) "Terror in Kenya".
- (iii) "Egypt and the Sudan — The People on the March".
- (iv) "The Housing Crisis in Capitalist and Colonial Countries".
- (v) "W.F.T.U. Campaigns for Social Security".
- (vi) "Towards the Third World Trade Union Congress".
- (vii) "Motor Car Industry faces growing Crisis".
- (viii) "Press Communique".
- (ix) "Federation of Vietnamese Youth".
- (x) "Hands off British Guiana".
- (xi) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "World Trade Union Movement".
- (xii) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "Information Bulletin".
- (xiii) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "World Youth".
- (xiv) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "Third World Youth Congress".
- (xv) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "Information Service".
- (xvi) All past or future issues of the periodical entitled "Soviet News".
