ORDER
Made Under
THE RICE (CESS) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 307).

WHEREAS by section 3(1) of the Rice (Cess) Ordinance, it is provided that the Governor may where it has been agreed between the Government of the Colony and the British Guiana Rice Marketing Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") that it is expedient so to do, by Order published in the Gazette authorize and direct the Board to pay to the Financial Secretary a Cess at such rate as may be specified in such Order, in respect of the proceeds of the sale of rice by the Board for consumption within the Colony;

AND WHEREAS it is provided under section 3(3) of the said Ordinance that any Order made under the provisions of section 3(1) thereof may, in like manner be varied or revoked by any subsequent Order;

AND WHEREAS in pursuance of the aforementioned powers the Board was authorised and directed by the Rice (Cess) Order, 1956*, to pay to the Financial Secretary a Cess on all rice sold by the Board for consumption within the Colony at certain rates specified therein;

AND WHEREAS it has been agreed between the Government of the Colony and the Board that it is expedient that with effect from 1st October, 1956, the said Cess shall no longer be paid:

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Rice (Cess) (Revocation) Order, 1956.
2. The Rice (Cess) Order, 1956*, is hereby revoked with effect from the 1st October, 1956.
