ORDER IN COUNCIL  
MADE UNDER  
THE SHOPS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 118)

UNDER THE PROVISIO TO SECTION 3 OF THE SHOPS ORDINANCE,  
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS  
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Shop Hours (Special Provision) (Singer Sewing Company) Order, 1956.

2. Without prejudice to the other provisions of the Shops Ordinance, but subject to the provisions of this Order, Singer Sewing Company (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") is hereby permitted to open its shop at Springlands, Corentyne, Berbice, during the hours set out in the schedule hereto.
