ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,  
Chapter 192.

UNDER SECTION 11(1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 192, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefitted by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be The Daily Argosy and The Daily Chronicle.

SCHEDULE

That area of land at Fyrish Village, Corentyne, bounded as follows:—

| On the North:— | by the Atlantic Ocean   |

| On the East:—  | by the ketting between Plns. Kilcoy and Fyrish.   |
| On the West:—  | by the ketting between Plns. Courtland and Fyrish.  |
