

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL  
Made Under  
THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the Daily Argosy and the Daily Chronicle.

SCHEDULE

That area comprising the Stanleytown Village District and the La Retraite Country District, West Bank, Demerara, bounded as follows:—

- On the north : by the common boundaries between Pln. Toevlugt and Pln. La Retraite and between Pln. L'Heureuse Adventure and Pln. La Retraite from the Demerara River to the common boundary between Pln. Middlesex and Pln. La Retraite;
- On the east : by the Demerara River from the common boundary between Pln. Toevlugt and Pln. La Retraite to the common boundary between Pln. La Retraite and Pln. Belle Vue;
- On the south : by the northern boundary of Canal No. 2 from the Demerara River to the common boundary between Pln. La Retraite and Pln. Middlesex;
- On the west : by the common boundary between Pln. La Retraite and Pln. Middlesex from the common boundary between Pln. L'Heureuse Adventure and Pln. La Retraite to the northern boundary of the Canal No. 2.
