ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 174).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Under section 2 of the above Ordinance, Desmond Montague Edg-hill, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the land described in paragraph 2 hereunder.

2. Under section 4 (1) (a) of the above Ordinance, the schedule to the said Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the area of land described in the schedule hereto—

SCHEDULE

“14. Plantations Buxton and Friendship situate on the East Sea Coast of Demerara and having an area of approximately 1,000 English Acres, and bounded as follows:—

On the north by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the east by the common boundary between Plantations Friendship and Vigilance and Crown Lands held under Licence No. 99 by the proprietors of Vigilance;

On the south by Grant No. 4592, held by the Village Council of Buxton and Friendship;

On the west by the common boundary between Plantations Buxton and La Reconnaissance and Crown Lands held under Licence No. 2754 by the proprietors of Lusignan cum annexis.”
