

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance as substituted by section 4(2) of the Customs Duties Ordinance (Chapter 310) and as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the substitution of the following for item 26 —

“Fish. 26. Morocut; also any other fish, crustacea and molluses caught by fishing boats operating from bascs in the Colony”.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1956.
