

ORDER MADE BY THE CONTROLLER OF SUPPLIES AND PRICES UNDER REGULATION 44 OF THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1939, AS EXTENDED BY THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS (SUPPLIES AND SERVICES) (CONTINUANCE) ORDER, 1946, TO CONTROL THE PRICES AT WHICH CERTAIN ARTICLES SHALL BE SOLD.

WITH the consent of the Officer Administering the Government, I DO HEREBY ORDER as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Prices (Amendment No. 1) Order, 1956, and shall be construed with the Control of Prices Order, 1955, (published in the Gazette of the 16th July, 1955) hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for item 6 First Schedule "FRESH BEEF" of the following—

(1) Item 6—Fresh Beef:—Plus 2 cents per lb. on all items sold on premises on which there is provided cold storage and refrigeration operating in connection with sales of such beef, such cold storage and refrigeration to be constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Competent Authority.

3. This Order shall come into effect at 6 a. m. on the 1st day of April, 1956.
4. Notice of the effect of this Order shall be given by publication of a copy thereof in the *Gazette*.
