ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT
(SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 174)

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT
(SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Under section 2 of the abovenamed Ordinance John Elliot Davis, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the land described in paragraph 2 hereunder.

2. Under section 4(1) (a) of the abovenamed Ordinance, the schedule to the said Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the area of land described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

“15. That portion of No. 48 Village, Corentyne, Berbice, extending 1,236 feet east of the Public road and 370 feet west of the Public Road and bounded on the north by Lot 47, on the east by the remaining portion of Lot 48, on the west by the remaining portion of Lot 48, and on the south by Lot 49, the said piece of land containing an approximate area of seven-five English acres and being part of Lot 48, as laid down and defined on a plan by James A. P. Bowhill, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 15th November, 1903, and as laid down and defined on a plan by John Peter Prass, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 18th May, 1880.”
