ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DIPLOMATIC PRIVILEGES (EXTENSION) ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 350).

UNDER SECTIONS 2 AND 3 OF THE DIPLOMATIC PRIVILEGES (EXTENSION) ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (World Health Organisation) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be read as one with the Diplomatic Privileges (World Health Organisation) Order, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. (1) The Principal Order shall have effect as if in Article 4 thereof references to representatives of member Governments included references to representatives of the Governments of Associate Members of the Organisation.

(2) For the purposes of this Order, the expression “representatives of the Governments of Associate Members of the Organisation” shall be deemed to include their official staffs, accompanying them as such representatives, as delegates, deputy delegates, advisers, technical experts or secretaries of delegations.
