

ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE LABOUR ORDINANCE
(Chapter 103.)

UNDER SECTION 8 (1) OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Building Trade Employees) Order, 1956.
2. In this Order —
“employee” means any person engaged in any of the occupations specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order in respect of his employment in the building trade or industry only.
3. Subject to the provisions of this Order the minimum rate of wage to be paid to an employee shall be as prescribed in the second column of the schedule to this Order.
4. This Order shall come into effect on the 21st day of April, 1956.
