

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 58)

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE AMERINDIAN ORDINANCE, IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Amerindian Area Order, 1957.
2. The area set out in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be an Amerindian Area.

SCHEDULE

That portion of the Moruca River in the North West Amerindian District, as defined by the Amerindian Districts Order, 1953 (No. 59), from Cayman Creek to the junction of the Moruca and the Bara Bara Rivers including all occupations and settlements on both banks thereof to be known as the Santa Rosa Amerindian Area.
