ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMALS DISEASES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Poultry Carcasses (Control) Order, 1956.
2. In this Order—  
“plucked” means having had all feathers and feather shafts removed;  
“eviscerated” means having had the entrails, heart, liver, lungs, pancreas and spleen (and ovaries where applicable), crop and gizzard removed.
3. On and after the date of the publication of this Order in the Gazette, poultry carcasses shall not be imported into the Colony unless they have been plucked, eviscerated, and the head and feet removed.
4. The importation into the Colony of all poultry feathers, or of the entrails, heart, liver, lungs, pancreas and spleen (and ovaries where applicable), crop or gizzard of any poultry is hereby prohibited.
5. The Importation of Poultry Carcasses (Control) Order\* 1955, is hereby rescinded.
