ORDER
MADE UNDER
THE PUBLIC HOLIDAYS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 61)

WHEREAS it is provided by section 3 of the Public Holidays Ordinance that the birthday of Her Majesty the Queen shall be a public holiday, unless it is ordered by the Governor, by an order published in the Gazette, that Her Majesty's birthday is to be kept on some other day, and then, that other day;

AND WHEREAS it is the wish of Her Majesty that her birthday in the year 1957 shall be celebrated on Monday, the 18th of March:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by the abovementioned section, and of all other powers him thereunto enabling, the Governor has been pleased to order that the birthday of Her Majesty the Queen in the year 1957 is to be kept on Monday, the 18th of March.
