

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL  
MADE UNDER  
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 (b) OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IT IS  
HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS  
FOLLOWS:—

Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (3) of item 48 thereof, and by the substitution therefor of the following:—

- “(3) (a) Goods officially imported or taken out of bond by and for the use of a de carriere Trade Commissioner or a de carriere Assistant Trade Commissioner including such a Trade Commissioner or Assistant Trade Commissioner who is not resident in the Colony but whose appointment includes the colony.
- (b) Goods imported on first arrival or at any time during his official residence by a de carriere Trade Commissioner or a de carriere Assistant Trade Commissioner for his personal use or the personal use of his family, if a similar privilege is accorded by the Government of which he is the representative to the de carriere Trade Commissioner and de carriere Assistant Trade Commissioners of the British West Indies.”
