ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 192)

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the Daily Argosy and the Daily Chronicle.

SCHEDULE

That area in and around Plantations New Hope, Friendship, and Garden of Eden, East Bank, Demerara, bounded as follows:—

On the North — by the common boundary between Craig and New Hope extending from the Demerara River to the western toe of the East Demerara Conservancy empolder dam:

On the East by the western toe of the East Demerara Conservancy empolder dam extending from the common boundary between Craig and New Hope to the Common boundary between Garden of Eden and Brickery;

On the South — by the common boundary between Garden of Eden and Brickery extending from the western toe of the East Demerara Conservancy empolder dam to the Demerara River;

On the West by the Demerara River extending along its right bank from the common boundary between Garden of Eden and Brickery to the common boundary between Craig and New Hope.
