

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LABOUR ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 103).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Hire Car Chauffeurs) Order, 1956.

2. In this Order —

“chauffeur” means a person employed to drive a hire car;

“normal hours” means the maximum number of hours which may normally be worked by a chauffeur in accordance with the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) Regulations.

3. (1) The minimum rate of wages payable to a chauffeur shall be fifteen dollars per week.

(2) The minimum rate of wages payable to a chauffeur for any shorter period of time than that set out in paragraph (1) of this article shall be the minimum rate of wages set out in the paragraph aforesaid.

4. (1) A chauffeur who, at the request of his employer works in excess of the normal hours, shall be paid for every hour or part thereof so worked at one and one-half times the rate at which he would be paid under this Order.”

(2) A chauffeur who, at the request of his employer, works in excess of the normal hours, shall be paid for every hour or part thereof so worked at one and one-half times the rate at which he would, but for this Order have been paid.

5. The Minimum Wages (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) Order, 1953, is hereby revoked.
