ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER
THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955.
(No. 30 of 1955).

UNDER SECTION 9 (5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1955, THE FOLLOWING ORDER
HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Vesting No. 4) Order, 1956.
2. The works described in the Schedule hereto shall vest in and become the property of the Board.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Facade drain across Orange Nassau, adjacent to and running parallel to on the southern side of the railway line from Orange Nassau East Side Line to Orange Nassau West Side Line.
- (2) Orange Nassau East Side Line trench for 200 rods southwards from the railway line.
- (3) Chapman's Grove West Side Line trench for 200 rods southwards from the railway line.
- (4) Facade drain across Chapman's Grove from its junction with the West Side Line at approximately 1,800 feet south of the railway line to its junction with the East Side Line.
