

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Order, 1956.

2. Owing to the suspected presence therein of cases of Foot and Mouth Disease the area described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be, for the purposes of the abovementioned Ordinance, a suspected area.

3. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.

SCHEDULE

That area bounded as follows—

On the north, by the parallel of latitude 5°N;

On the east, by the boundary between the Colony and Dutch Guiana;

On the south, by the boundary between the Colony and Brazil;

On the west, by the Ireng and Takatu Rivers.
