ORDER IN COUNCIL

Made Under

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 258).

UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) (No. 2) Order, 1956.
2. Owing to the presence therein of cases of Foot and Mouth Disease the area described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be, for the purpose of the abovementioned Ordinance, an area infected with Foot and Mouth Disease.
3. The Animal Diseases (Foot and Mouth Disease) Order, 1954\*, is hereby revoked.
4. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.

SCHEDULE

That area bounded as follows—

- On the north and west, by the boundary between the Colony and Venezuela;
- On the north and east, by the boundary between the Colony and Brazil;
- On the west by the parallel of longitude 61° 30' W;
- On the south, by the parallel of latitude 1° 20' N.
