ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER.

THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 143)

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Albamycin) Order, 1956.
2. The following is hereby declared to be an antibiotic to which the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance shall apply —

Albamycin, all compounds of Albamycin and all medicinal preparations containing albamycin.
