ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE EAST DEMERARA WATER CONSERVANCY ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 236)

UNDER SECTION 51 (c) OF THE EAST DEMERARA WATER CONSERVANCY ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the East Demerara Water Conservancy (Additional Rate Assessment) Order, 1956.
2. An additional rate shall be assessed by the East Demerara Water Conservancy Board for a period of ten years commencing from the year 1957, on all the plantations included in the first schedule of the East Demerara Water Conservancy Ordinance, to repay a loan of forty thousand dollars to be raised to defray the cost of a new dredger and pontoon, and the annual payment by the Mayor and Town Council of Georgetown to the Board in respect thereof shall be fixed at two hundred and fifty dollars.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st of January, 1957.
