

BRITISH GUIANA**ORDER IN COUNCIL
Made Under
THE EXPLOSIVES ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 346).**

UNDER SECTION 29(1) OF THE EXPLOSIVES ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This order may be cited as the Fireworks Order, 1957.
2. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 3 of this Order, the manufacture, keeping, importation, conveyance and sale of fireworks is hereby prohibited.
3. The Governor may authorise the importation of any particular consignment of fireworks if, on application made to him in respect of that consignment, he is satisfied that it is intended to use the same solely for purposes of public entertainment and that its use for such purposes will not endanger public safety.

4. The Fireworks Order* is hereby revoked.
