IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION
4 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY
AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE
THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

Citation. 1. This Order, which amends the Ministers, Members of
the National Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) Order*,
may be cited as the Ministers, Members of the National As-
sembly and Special Offices (Allowances) (Amendment) (No. 2)
Order 1984.

Amendment
of the Sche-
dule to the
Principal
Order. 2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended
by the substitution for subparagraph (3) of paragraph 1 of the
following subparagraph —

“(3) The Prime Minister, every other Minister, the At-
torney-General and the Speaker of the National As-
sembly shall each be entitled to employ two
chauffeurs and shall be paid in respect of each
chauffeur an allowance of not less than \$720 per
month nor more than \$810 per month to be deter-
mined by the Minister responsible for finance to
meet the expenses incurred by him in respect of
the employment of the chauffeurs.”.
