

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 150).

UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Golden Fleece—Eldorado Village District (Elections) Order, 1960.

2. For the purpose of the election of councillors, the Golden Fleece-Eldorado Village District, on the west coast of the county of Berbice is hereby divided into four divisions, namely, the Golden Fleece Division, the Paradise Division, the Belladrum Division and the Eldorado Division, the boundaries of which are described in the schedule hereto.

3. The number of councillors appointed to be elected by each division shall be as follows :—

- (a) by the Golden Fleece Division, three councillors;
- (b) by the Paradise Division, three councillors;
- (c) by the Belladrum Division, three councillors; and
- (d) by the Eldorado Division, three councillors.

SCHEDULE

1. (Boundaries of the Golden Fleece Division)

On the north-west by the sideline dam between Golden Fleece and Paradise;

On the south-east by the Ketting between Plantations Golden Fleece and Weldaad;

On the north-east by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the south-west by the Abary River.

2. (Boundaries of the Paradise Division)

On the north-west by the sideline dam between Plantations Paradise and Belladrum;

On the south-east by the sideline dam between Paradise and Golden Fleece;

On the north-east by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the south-west by the Abary River.

3. (Boundaries of the Belladrum Division)

On the north-west by the sideline dam between Belladrum and Eldorado;
On the south-east by the sideline dam between Plantations Belladrum and Paradise;

On the north-east by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the south-west by the Abary River.

4. (Boundaries of the Eldorado Division)

On the north-west by the Ketting between Plantation Eldorado and Plantation Foulis, the Abary River and Plantation Foulis Hole;

On the south-east by the sideline dam between Eldorado and Belladrum;

On the north-east by the Atlantic Ocean;

On the south-west by the Abary River.
