ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 47 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Bel Air Park) (Amendment) Order, 1960, and shall be construed and read as one with the Road Traffic (Bel Air Park) Order, 1958*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby varied by the revocation of article 4 thereof.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 1st day of January, 1960.
