ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE WAGES COUNCILS ORDINANCE, 1956.

(No. 51 of 1956)

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE WAGES COUNCILS ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wages Council (Saw Mill Workers) Order, 1960.

2. There shall be established in respect of the Workers to whom this Order applies as set out in the Schedule hereto, and their employers, a wages council to be known as the Saw Mill Workers Wages Council.

3. This Order shall come into operation on publication in the Gazette.

SCHEDULE

1. This Order shall apply to all workers who are employed in British Guiana by any person or persons carrying on a saw mill, and who are engaged mainly or wholly in any capacity in connection with the operation of a saw mill.

2. For the purpose of this schedule "saw mill" means any place where wood is prepared by mechanical process for building purposes.
