ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.
2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be The Daily Chronicle and The Daily Argosy.

SCHEDULE

That area in and around the Jackson Creek and the Moleson Creek on the Corentyne River, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at the southern boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area at its junction with the left bank of the Corentyne River and proceeding in a westerly direction along the aforesaid southern boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area to its junction with the western boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area, thence in a northerly direction along the aforesaid western boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area to its junction with the northern boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area, thence in a westerly direction along the prolongation westward of the northern boundary of the Crabwood Creek Drainage and Irrigation Area for a distance of approximately 23,600 feet, thence in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 45,000 feet thence in an easterly direction to the left bank of the Corentyne River, thence in a northerly direction along the left bank of the Corentyne River to the point of commencement.
