ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT (SPECIAL
PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 174)

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT
(SPECIAL PROCEDURE) ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED
BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. In pursuance of section 2 of the District Lands Partition and Re-allotment (Special Procedure) Ordinance, Desmond Montague Edghill, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the person to partition and re-allot, or to re-allot the land referred to in paragraph 2 hereunder.

2. In pursuance of section 4(1) (a) of the District Lands Partition and Re-allotment (Special Procedure) Ordinance, the schedule to the said Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the area of land described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

“27. Cotton Tree and Zee Zight Village District situate on the left bank of the Berbice River, in the County of Berbice, British Guiana, bounded:—

On the east by the Berbice River;

On the west by a tract of 1753.26 acres of Crown land held by the proprietors of Plantation Cotton Tree under Licence of Occupancy No. A 105;

On the north by the common boundary on the side line dam between Plantation Mon Choisi or No. 3 and Plantation Zee Zight; and

On the south by the Ketting between Plantation Cotton Tree and D'Edward, and comprising an area of approximately 1668 English acres.”
