## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

## THE MINING ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 196).

UNDER SECTION 36(1) OF THE MINING ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Kopinang-Sukabi Mining Area (Closing) Order, 1960.

2. The area of unoccupied Crown lands as described in the schedule hereto is hereby declared to be closed to prospecting or mining or the locating of claims under any prospecting licence for bauxite.

## SCHEDULE

A tract of Crown land commencing at a point on the left bank of the Potaro river about 2 miles below the mouth of the Kwitara river, a branch of Potaro river, and extending thence approximately N 330° for a distance of about 33 miles to the source of the Semang river, thence along a straight line to the source of the Potaro river and along the foothills of Powis and Arodima, thence in a southerly direction to a point on the Sukabi river about 4½ miles from its mouth, thence along the northern foothills of the Wokomung Mountain, thence along the watershed between the Potaro and Ireng rivers and along the foothills of Kopinang, Surabaru, Anandabaru, Samballi, Muribang and Kowatipau to the source of the Chenapau river, thence along the left bank of the Chenapau river to its mouth, thence along the left bank of the Potaro river back to the point of commencement, and containing an approximate area of 900 square miles.
