## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

## THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE

(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11 (1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the Daily Argosy and the Guiana Graphic.

## SCHEDULE

That area of land lying between the Mahaica and Berbice Rivers bounded as follows:—

- (a) On the North by the Atlantic Ocean.
- (b) On the South by a straight line extending from the left bank of the Berbice River at its junction with the Dailuku River to the source of the uppermost tributary of the Abary River thence by a straight line to the source of the uppermost tributary of the Mahaicony River thence by a straight line to the source of the uppermost tributary of the Mahaica River.
- (c) On the East by the Left Bank, Berbice River.
- (d) On the West by the Right Bank, Mahaica River.
