

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11(1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS :—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the schedule hereto is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.

2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the "Daily Argosy" and the "Guiana Graphic".

SCHEDULE

That area of land being a portion of the Ordnance Fort Lands, situate on the right bank of the Berbice River, bounded as follows —

- On the north — by the sea dam running across Ordnance Fort Lands from its junction with the western sea dam to its junction with the common boundary between Ordnance Fort Lands and Lot No. 1.
- On the east — by the common boundary between Ordnance Fort Lands and Lot No. 1 from its junction with the sea dam to a point approximately 1,000 feet north of the Grand Canal.
- On the south — by a line approximately 1,000 feet north of and parallel to the Grand Canal from its junction with the common boundary between Ordnance Fort Lands and Lot No. 1, to its junction with the sea dam.
- On the west — by the sea dam from a point approximately 1,000 feet north of the Grand Canal to its junction with the northern sea dam.
