ORDER IN COUNCIL.

MADE UNDER

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IT IS
HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS
FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers (Industries Aid and Encouragement) (Hotel Furniture and Equipment) Order, 1960.

2. The Financial Secretary is hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor in Council the power specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order conferred on the Governor in Council by the Ordinance mentioned in the second column of the said schedule, subject, however, to the following conditions and qualifications —

- (a) that the delegation of power effected by this Order shall remain in force only until varied or revoked by the Governor in Council;
- (b) that the exercise of the power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any directions, either general or particular, which the Governor in Council may from time to time give in that respect.
