ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 23(5) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Construction) (No. 2) Order, 1960.

2. The Board shall cause to be constructed, within the Lancaster/Manchester Drainage and Irrigation Area, at an estimated cost of \$19,000.00, the drainage and irrigation works described in the schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

(1) A facade drain commencing 291 rods south of the public road in the Manchester east sideline and proceeding in a westerly direction to a point 249 rods south of the public road in the Liverpool east sideline thence to a point 212 rods south of public road in the Liverpool east sideline and then to a point 190 rods south of the public road in the Lancaster east sideline;

(2) three greenheart check sluices, one each in the Manchester, Liverpool and Lancaster west sidelines at their junctions with the above facade drain respectively;

(3) two greenheart bridges, 12 feet wide across the above facade drain at its junctions with the dams between Manchester and Liverpool, and between Liverpool and Lancaster respectively;

(4) a fence running parallel to and north of the above facade drain; and

(5) three greenheart panels, one each in the Manchester, Liverpool and Lancaster east sidelines at their junctions with the Gordon dam.
