ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTIONS 47 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR-IN-COUNCIL :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (One-Way Streets) Order, 1960.
2. (a) No vehicle shall proceed north in or along the eastern side of East Street.
(b) No vehicle shall proceed south in or along the western side of East Street.
3. No vehicle shall proceed in a westerly direction in or along Third Street from its junction with Albert Street to its junction with Cummings Street.
4. No vehicle shall proceed in an easterly direction in or along Fourth Street from its junction with Cummings Street to its junction with Albert Street.
5. No vehicle shall proceed in a westerly direction in or along Hope Street from its junction with Main Street to its junction with Water Street.
6. No vehicle shall proceed in an easterly direction in or along Holmes Street from its junction with Water Street to its junction with Main Street.
7. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1960.
