ORDER IN COUNCIL  
MADE UNDER  
THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 143).

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL HAS ORDERED AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Ambramycin and Synthomycetine) Order, 1960.

2. The following are hereby declared to be antibiotics to which the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance\* shall apply —

Ambramycin, all compounds of Ambramycin and all medical preparations containing Ambramycin;

Synthomycetine, all compounds of Synthomycetine and all medical preparations containing Synthomycetine.
