ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTIONS 47 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Road Traffic (Georgetown) Order, 1956*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby varied by the deletion of article 6 thereof and the substitution therefor of the following —

“6(a) No vehicle shall proceed north in or along the eastern side of Waterloo Street.

(b) No vehicle shall proceed south in or along the western side of Waterloo Street.”

3. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of August, 1960.
