ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959

(No. 18 of 1959).

UNDER SECTION 17(1) OF THE LAND REGISTRY ORDINANCE, 1959,  
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS  
FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Land Registry (Registration Area) (Union/Ross, West Coast, Berbice) Order, 1960.
2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order shall be a registration area.

SCHEDULE

Commencing at the point where the common boundary between Plantations Union and Trafalgar meets the shore line of the Atlantic Ocean, and extending thence in a south westerly direction along the said common boundary of Plantations Union and Trafalgar to the back boundary of Plantation Union, thence in a north westerly direction along the back boundaries of Plantations Union, Tempe, Britannia, Chester, Yeovil and Ross thence in a north easterly direction along the common boundary between plantations Ross and Brahan to the shore line of the Atlantic Ocean, and thence in a south easterly direction along the shore line of the Atlantic Ocean to the point of commencement.
