

BRITISH GUIANA.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 5).

UNDER SECTION 40 OF THE INTERPRETATION ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Delegation of Powers (Miscellaneous Provisions) Order, 1960.

2. The persons specified in the first column of the schedule to this Order are hereby deputed to exercise on behalf of the Governor in Council the powers specified in the second column of the said schedule conferred on the Governor in Council by the enactments mentioned in the third column of the said schedule, subject however, to the following conditions and qualifications —

- (a) that the delegation of each power effected by this Order shall remain in force only until it is varied or revoked by the Governor in Council;
- (b) that the exercise of any power delegated by this Order shall be subject to any direction, either general or particular, which the Governor in Council may from time to time give in that respect.
