ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 280)

UNDER SECTIONS 47 AND 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Georgetown) (One-Way Streets) (No. 2) Order, 1960.
2. No vehicle shall proceed in a westerly direction in or along America Street from its junction with High Street to its junction with Water Street.
3. No vehicle shall proceed in a westerly direction in or along Robb Street from its junction with Orange Walk to its junction with Alexander Street.
4. No vehicle shall proceed in a southerly direction in or along Cummings Street from its junction with Third Street to its junction with Fourth Street.
5. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1961.
