ORDER IN COUNCIL
MADE UNDER
THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 192).

UNDER SECTION 11(1) OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ORDINANCE, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL :—

1. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area described in the Schedule hereto, or any part thereof, is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.
2. The daily newspapers in which this Order is to be published shall be the "Daily Chronicle" and the "Guiana Graphic".

SCHEDULE

That area in and around Pln. Soesdyke, East Bank, Demerara, the boundaries of which shall be as follows:—

Commencing at the junction of the western prolongation of the southern boundary of Lot 1 with the right bank of the Demerara River and proceeding thence S 53°44' E (true) for a distance of approximately 6,200 feet to a concrete beacon "J.L.Y.", thence N 90° E (true) for a distance of approximately 3,293 feet to a concrete beacon "J.L.Y.", thence along a line bearing N 30° E (true) to its junction with the northern edge of the Kakabura trench thence westwards along the aforesaid northern edge of the Kakabura trench to its junction with the right bank of the Demerara River thence upstream along the right bank of the Demerara River to the point of commencement:
