## ORDER IN COUNCIL

## MADE UNDER

THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 179).

UNDER SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Black Bush—Canje Grazing Area) Order, 1961.

2. Under section 3 of the abovenamed Ordinance, the proposed construction of four main drains with banks on both sides and two distributaries with banks on both sides on the land described in the schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be a public work.

3. Under section 4 of the said Ordinance, the Director of Drainage and Irrigation, together with his agents, servants or workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the land set out in the schedule to this Order for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or of part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

## SCHEDULE

A tract of land situate on the right bank of the Canje River in the County of Berbice and Colony of British Guiana, the boundaries of which are as follows:—

Commencing at a point on the right bank of the Canje River at the south-western extremity of the left bank of the Port Mourant No. 2 Water Path and extending thence in a north-easterly direction along the left bank of the Port Mourant Water Path to the eastern boundary of Tract "B" of Lease No. A 6411, thence in a southerly direction along the eastern boundary of Tract "B" of Lease No. A 6411 and the prolongation thereof to the northern boundary of Grant No. 3701, thence in an easterly direction along the northern boundary of Grant No. 3701 to the eastern or back boundary of Grant No. 3701, thence up river along the back boundaries of all Grants, Leases and Permissions situate on the right bank of the Canje River between Grant No. 3701 aforesaid and the south-eastern boundary of Grant No. 4657 approximately half a mile above the Yakusari Creek, thence in a south-westerly direction along the south-eastern boundary of Grant No. 4657 to the right bank of the Canje River thence in a northerly direction or down-stream along the right bank of the Canje River back to the point of commencement.
