

BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 115).

UNDER SECTION 30 OF THE FACTORIES ORDINANCE THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Factories Ordinance (Exemption) Order, 1961.

2. The occupations specified in Part I of the Schedule to this Order in the classes of factory specified in Part II of the said Schedule shall be exempted from the provisions of section 29 of the Factories Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

Part I

Employment by the Transport and Harbours Department in the following capacities —

Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, Clerk-in-Charge, Senior Clerk, Clerk, Foreman, Assistant Foreman, Charge-Hand, Book-keeper, Cashier, Time-keeper or Watchman.

Part II

Docks, wharves, quays, stellings, warehouses, workshops and garages, operated by the Transport and Harbours Department; and all machinery or plant used in the processes of loading or unloading or refuelling or repairing any ship or vessel in any dock or harbour or at any wharf, quay or stelling, operated by the Transport and Harbours Department.
