THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) Order, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order, 1959, *hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the second schedule thereto and the substitution therefor of the following:—
